Free Shredding Offered in Boulder this Saturday

Boulder, CO — As a way to help people keep their personal information private and to prevent identity theft, Elevations Credit Union is offering a free shredding service to the public this Saturday, November 7th.

The event takes place from 9:00 a.m. to Noon in the parking lot of the Elevations Credit Union branch located at 2960 Diagonal Highway in Boulder. The Cintas Document Management Company will bring a mobile document shredding truck for on-the-spot destruction.

Anyone, credit union members or not, may bring up to three file-sized boxes of confidential and personal documents such as financial statements, tax returns and personal health records. There is no cost for this service.
