Elevations Foundation makes \$81k donation to benefit Fourmile Fire Victims

Boulder, CO — The Elevations Foundation has distributed \$81,000.00 from its Fourmile Fire Relief Fund. This fund was established on September 8th and as a result of the generosity of Elevations members and the community overall, funds are flowing to fire victims and local firefighting agencies.

Elevations is working in concert with Boulder County Community Services, the Foothills United Way and the Community Foundation Serving Boulder County in the disbursement of funds. “These organizations have worked tirelessly to see that victims are identified and needs are being met,” said Dennis Paul, Elevations Credit Union Assistant Vice President for Business and Community Development. “We are pleased to be able to help in the relief efforts and provide funding through our Foundation to provide a source of cash resources,” he added.
