Elevations Foundation accepts Reservoir Road Fire Relief Donations

Boulder, CO — Less than a week after a devastating fire scorched thousands of acres and destroyed 166 homes in the foothills just west of Boulder, CO; another major wildfire has roared through an area just west of Loveland, CO. For the fire in Boulder, Elevations Credit Union moved quickly to establish a fund to support fire relief efforts through its Foundation. The organization is now doing the same to support those impacted in the Loveland area.

“All money donated on behalf of the Reservoir Road fire will go directly to those aiding in this fire relief effort and to those families who have lost their homes or been displaced,” said Gerry Agnes, President and CEO. “In addition, Elevations Foundation will match all donations up to \$10,000 in total.”

Elevations Foundation, which is the official charitable arm of Elevations Credit Union, is accepting donations towards the Reservoir Road fire relief efforts.
